Power Plugs & Euros?

I have received the following question that may be of general interest:

Do you have any suggestions for things like power plugs, euros, etc.?

The power plugs are:

Most phone adapters and other electronics are rated for 100 to 220 volts. Check to make sure yours are. If they are, you only need the plug adapter. In the larger hotels, they have 110V shaver plugs in the bathrooms that can be used to plug in small phone chargers. Even newer hair dryers are available for 100 to 220 volts. Again, check yours to make sure and bring a plug adapter. The larger hotels will supply hair dryers and have adapters. Our AAA offices usually have a travel store with adapters.



Euros:

It is good to have enough Euros to pay tips getting to your first hotel. Then, get Euros at an ATM near the hotel. If you don't have Euros, you can tip in \$US until you get Euros. We try to charge everything but you have to have chip+PIN cards for most places. That would be an ATM card with a chip for us. Some places will take chip credit cards. For us, that is usually the best deal since ATM cards usually have transaction fees for us. Make sure your ATM and Credit Cards have chips. Then toward the end of the trip I try to use up most of the Euros.
